

SHAPING THE FUTURE

IN WHAT WAY?

- Provide improved access to the church for all.
- Provide a parking space for those with special needs
- Install disabled toilet in church vestibule and also in halls at the back of the premises.
- Upgrade existing toilets at the entrance to the church halls.
- Extend and upgrade the kitchen serving the main church hall.
- Replace windows with double glazed units in the main hall in order to conserve energy.
- Replace the heating boilers in order to improve efficiency and conserve energy.
- Improve the storage capacities for all hall users.
- Level floor of sanctuary to give more flexible floor space and better seating arrangements.
- improve lighting and upgrade heating and draught proofing in the church sanctuary.

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WHAT WILL IT COST?

We are working to an estimate to include all known costs and VAT of **£440,000**. There will be no overspend or borrowing.

HOW WILL IT BE PAID FOR?

We are fortunate to have received legacies and have the church house in Woodhall Avenue to sell.

We have also contacted several charitable trusts and although the response has been respectable so far we are hoping for better results to come.

However, we will require donations from church members, those who make use of the facilities, members of the local community and other supporters.
